Love Côte d'Ivoire Festival: Prayer and Intercession Needs

In June several significant things happened that we can give thanks to God for:

- We were able to rent an office for the festival
- Several staff members that were needed was recruited and appointed
- The committee meetings went well with much progress being made
- Some of the Palau team was able to preach in churches with many people committing their lives to Christ
- Strong strategic relationships were formed and strengthened

General Needs

All the local staff, Palau team, committee leaders and members need prayer for:

- Wisdom as we continue working toward the festival
- Direction in several key areas where decisions are needed
- Good and clear communication
- Unity amongst each other and the people we're working with
- Good health and protection as the work continues

Specific Needs

The following needs are specific areas that we need prayer cover for in July:

- Mobilization of all churches in Yamoussoukro to attend the 7 Zonal meetings in August. Pray for the Church Mobilization Committee as they contact all the churches to invite them to these meetings.
- Pastor's Launch in September – pray for the arrangements to fall in place for the launch and people to accept the invitation.
- Media & publicity implementation – pray for key contacts that will help with implementing the strategy for this key area. Also, much direction and wisdom is needed to implement a thorough campaign across the city.
- Technical production – pray for the team as they try and source the needed technical equipment including generators, bouncy castles, tents etc.

- Interpreters – pray for the right interpreters that can help the Palau team in their future visits, during the festival and particularly Andrew when he preaches during the festival.
- Children’s workers – pray that the right volunteers will be recruited in this area.
- Prison outreach – pray for favour with the local authorities in the prison.
- Prayer strategy – pray for the prayer committee as they work on a strategy that will cover the festival in prayer and intercession.
- Women’s and business leader’s dinners – pray that the correct location will be found and that good prices will be negotiated for the dinners.
- Passion for the lost – pray that God will prepare the hearts of the Christians in the city with a passion to see their lost friends and family saved.
