From this campaign, we’re celebrating:

- More than 19,000 decisions for Jesus.
- More than 102,000 people reached in person with the Good News of Jesus Christ.
- 59 nations reached through live television broadcast across the French-speaking world.
- More than 10,000 individuals served through eyeglass clinics around the city.
- More than 9,000 children reached through programs in schools and BMX outreaches.
- More than 5,000 individuals trained in personal evangelism.
- 418 local evangelists gathered for the launch of the first-ever network of evangelists in Cote d’Ivoire.
- More than 2,200 partnering churches – a truly historical effort.

Additionally, **praise the Lord for NGA members Keith Cook, Zack Blickens, and Rick Wilson**, who ministered to thousands in Eldoret, Kenya last month in schools, prisons, marketplaces, and a city-wide festival. There were more than 4,000 decisions for Jesus! **NGA member Alan Greene** also served in Abidjan where he shared the Gospel numerous times equipping and training local evangelists and sharing the Good News with others.
