### **SOUTHERN CARIBBEAN -- URGENT!**

Please join in heartfelt prayer as multiple Hurricanes have devastated the Southern Caribbean Islands. St. Thomas, St. John, Puerto Rico, Cuba, Dominican Republic, and many small islands have been hit hard by these storms. Randy Burtis, our Caribbean coordinator, has been in contact with pastors and other church leaders since the devastation in St. Thomas, Haiti, Antigua, and the Grenadines. St. Thomas seems to have been hit the hardest among that group. But, all these islands have sustained enormous damage to homes, churches, and some loss of life. Right now, of course, they are focused on recovery more than future plans for evangelism with LPA.
